Segovia is a millennial city situated only 87 km from Madrid which was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1985. The city is located at the edge of the Sierra de Guadarrama National Park and is surrounded by a green belt formed by the valleys of the Eresma and Clamores rivers.

It is considered one of the most beautiful cities in the world due to its extraordinary monuments and environment. Segovia has been the protagonist of great events throughout the history of Spain, and today it is characterized by cultural dynamism, great gastronomy in addition to its impressive heritage like the Roman Aqueduct, which, being almost 2000 years old.

Segovia is a quiet city of 51,000 inhabitants, characterized by a great cultural life, a pleasant youthful atmosphere and a wide range of leisure activities since it hosts three universities. Learning Spanish in Segovia, in addition to immersing yourself in the Spanish language and culture, will allow you to enjoy a unique experience.
